### **Overview**

Step beyond typical sightseeing with this rare opportunity to explore the sacred grounds of Oyama Afuri Shrine, guided by a Shinto priest. Participate in the Osame-dachi wooden sword offering ritual, a solemn ceremony recognized as part of Japan Heritage. This experience offers a deeper understanding of Edo-period culture and the spiritual roots of Bushido and Shinto.

The program also features a display and sale of traditional local craft, such as the Oyama Koma (wooden spinning top), handcrafted by a skilled local craftsperson. Participants can engage directly with this craftsperson and experience elements of Edo-period culture through folk toys and regional craftsmanship.

It also offers meaningful opportunities to connect with the shrine priest and a local artisan.

## Kanagawa / Isehara









### Overview

This program follows the same flow as Tour ①, featuring a pilgrimage walk, shrine visit, Osame-dachi ritual, meeting a local craftsperson, and tea time. Guests stay overnight at a traditional pilgrim lodge at the foot of Mt. Ōyama, just as pilgrims did in the 17th century. Before a refined tofu-centered dinner, enjoy a private performance of Noh and Gagaku (ancient court music), with the rare chance to touch masks and traditional instruments. The next morning includes exclusive early shrine access, breakfast, and closing words from the inn's priest-owner.

### **Sales Points**

- Walk the pilgrimage path and stay in a pilgrim lodge, rare experiences beyond what casual visitors can access.
- Gain deeper insight into Japanese philosophy and spirituality through thoughtful explanations that turn this program into a meaningful journey of understanding Japanese culture.
